To Whom It May Concern:

The 35th annual *Nutrien Children's Festival of Saskatchewan* (legal name: *Northern Saskatchewan International Children's Festival*) will take place from June 1st to June 4th, 2023, in Kinsmen, Saskatoon. We will begin setting up on May 24th, 2023.
